- **B.** Senate minority leader threatens a filibuster with cloture-proof minority

Conference:

- E. House & Senate leaders appoint hostile conferees to the Conference Committee
- **D.** Conference committee can't agree on identical bills to report out
- C. Conference committee fundamentally changes bill & reports it out
- **B.** House & Senate leaders don't schedule a vote on conference report
- **A.** House & Senate vote down the conference report

President:

- A. Bill is passed by Congress but vetoed by the President
- **B.** Congress fails to override the presidential veto
